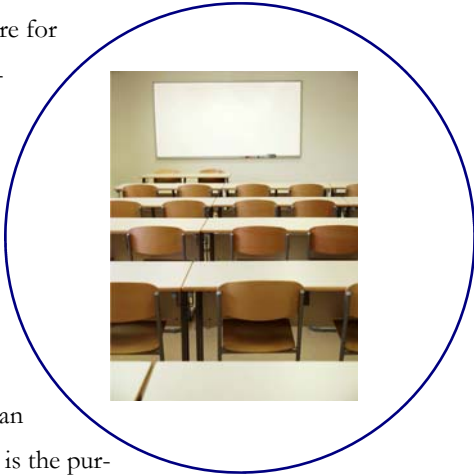


Dear Prospective Student,
